There must have been about 25 or 30 soldiers there. Everyone took a tract and said thank you. One of the last soldiers I handed a tract to, whose name was Zach, looked at the tract and said to me, "Wow! I just got here and I am looking for a Baptist church." Zach is very excited about coming to visit Calvary Baptist Church. Who would have ever thought that on the side of a mountain, in Italy, in the middle of a town with nothing in it, that we would meet and have the opportunity to spread the gospel to a bunch of US soldiers and meet one that was looking for a Baptist church. One thing I am glad of is that we normally have plenty of tracts with us.

A couple weeks ago one of the ladies in our church called me and said that her son, Timothy, came to her and wanted to talk to me about getting saved. Timothy is 7 years old and very intelligent. When we met that day Timothy told me that the Lord has been speaking to his heart about getting saved. I asked Timothy what he thought a person must do to be saved and he told me he must trust in Jesus but also you must be baptized. We opened the Bible and as I pointed out the verses he read the scriptures out loud and read very well. As I explained from the scripture to Timothy the only way to Heaven is by trusting Jesus as his Saviour and Jesus alone, he told me that he understood and wanted to pray and trust Jesus as his Saviour.
